A total of 4 hours per semester is mandatory for continued membership. The final 4 hours must be completed the week before the Induction Ceremony. The service hours shall be voluntary contributions of a musical nature made by a student to the school or community, *done without compensation* (such as financial compensation, academic credit, public notoriety, reward or development toward future academics or occupation), and with a positive, courteous, and enthusiastic spirit. To help you discern which of your activities falls under the above definition, we have provided the following examples:

DOES NOT APPLY

- performing for a wedding for a fee
- tutoring an 8th grader on cello for pay

Does Apply

- performing at the tree lightning ceremony without pay
- tutoring a freshman on trumpet that your band teacher set you up with during your free period or after school

Any questions regarding the acceptability of an activity for which you would like counted as service must be discussed with the advisor <u>before</u> the hours due date. The interpretation of the above definition and the resulting acceptability or unacceptability of an activity listed in your application as service is ultimately up to the music staff.
